TENDER TITLE: CERTIFICATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF THE FISCAL YEARS 2022 AND 2023

1. Introduction

The University of Technology and Arts of Byumba (UTAB) invites qualified external audit firms to submit applications for an open tender to conduct the certification of its Financial Statements for the fiscal years 2022 and 2023. This process aims to ensure the accuracy, transparency, and compliance of the university's financial reporting with applicable standards and regulations.

2. Background

The University of Technology and Arts of Byumba (UTAB) is a fully accredited community-based university. It started as Institut Polytechnique de Byumba (IPB) and began teaching on 26th January 2006 in Byumba Sector, Gicumbi District, Northern Province, Rwanda. On 20th December 2015, IPB upgraded from the status of institute to that of university under the name of University of Technology and Arts of Byumba (UTAB). Currently, UTAB runs three faculties fully accredited by HEC. These include the Faculty of Social Sciences, Management and Development Studies (SSMDS), the Faculty of Education, and the Faculty of Agriculture, Environmental Management and Renewable Energy (FAEMRE). In addition, UTAB has Distance and Open Learning facility (DOLF) located in Gatsibo District, Kiramuruzi Sector. UTAB journey of more than 15 years has been long but very fulfilling. As a university, UTAB is engaged in different activities such as academic, research and community outreach. All of those activities aim at raising the quality of education and social transformation.

This call for application of certifying the University of Technology and Arts of Byumba's financial statements aims to provide an independent and professional assurance that the university's financial records are accurate, complete, and compliant with applicable financial reporting standards

2.1. Vision of UTAB

The vision of UTAB is to become a radiating university of academic and professional excellence for sustainable socio-economic development.

3. Scope of Work

The selected audit firm will perform the following tasks:

- **Financial Audits**: Conduct comprehensive audits of UTAB's financial statements for the fiscal years 2022 and 2023. This will include reviewing balance sheets, income statements, cash flow statements, and other financial records.
- Compliance Audit: Ensure that UTAB's financial practices comply with Rwandan laws, International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), and other relevant regulations.
- **Internal Control Review**: Evaluate the effectiveness of the university's internal control systems in managing and safeguarding assets.
- **Audit Report Preparation**: Produce detailed reports on the findings, including any discrepancies, recommendations for improvements, and the overall financial health of the institution.
- Presentation of Findings: Present the audit findings to the university's management and the Board
 of Directors, addressing any questions or concerns raised.

4. Bid Submission Requirements

Firms interested in this tender are required to submit the following documents:

- · Company profile and experience
- Technical Proposal:
 - Detailed work plan, including the audit methodology, timeline, and scope of work;
 - o Company profile outlining past experience, relevant projects, and client references;
 - o List of the key audit personnel, their qualifications, and certifications;
 - Description of the firm's audit approach and tools.
- Financial Proposal:
 - Breakdown of costs, including fees for auditing services, any additional costs (travel, administrative), and payment terms;
 - o Proposed payment schedule.
- Legal Documents:
 - Copy of the firm's business registration certificate;
 - o Proof of valid tax clearance from the Rwandan Revenue Authority;
 - o Insurance coverage certificate.

All applications must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked " Application for the Certification of UTAB Financial Statements" at UTAB Reception Office.

The deadline for submission of applications is Friday, on 25th October, 2024, at 12:00 pm.

Late applications will not be considered.

The bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 12:30pm, on Friday, 25th October, 2024 at the UTAB Main Campus.

5. Eligibility Criteria

Eligible external audit firms must meet the following requirements:

- **Registration and Licensing**: The firm must be legally registered and authorized to conduct audits in Rwanda.
- **Professional Qualifications**: The firm's lead auditors must hold valid certifications such as Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or equivalent.
- **Experience**: A minimum of 3 years of experience in auditing higher education institutions or similar organizations.
- Reputation: Demonstrable experience with successful audits in the education sector, supported by client references.
- **Compliance**: The firm must adhere to the International Standards on Auditing (ISA) and other relevant standards.

6. Evaluation Criteria

The following eligibility criteria will be taken into account in the analysis and evaluation of the bids:

- The firm must be duly registered and legally authorized to conduct business in Rwanda;
- Demonstrated experience in conducting feasibility studies for educational infrastructure projects;
- Price competitiveness;
- Tax Clearance Certificate;
- Past performance recommendations and references;
- Compliance with Tender Requirements.
